Did you know?

Lavandula Stoechas



Lavender belongs to the Lamiaceae (Labiatae) family, a group of plants that include the mints (Mentha).

The genus *Lavandula* is divided into five different sections: Stoechas, Spica, Pterostoechas, Chaetostachys and Subnuda.

Stoechas is a group easily identified by the large, petal-like sterile bracts (rabbit's ears) at the top of the spike.



Being frost tolerant, they will flower most of the year with short intermittent breaks.

And did you know that all Stoechas-group lavender have been declared noxious plants in Tasmania and rural Victoria?
