**Window Cleaning**

Grimy windows that do not come clean with soapy water may well respond better if lavender vinegar is used.

Dampen a cloth with the vinegar and rub vigorously. Remember to leave a trace of the vinegar in the corners of the frames as this will create a pleasant smell after you have finished.

*How to make lavender vinegar*

A method of making lavender vinegar is to fill a glass jar with lavender, add some lemon verbena and mint leaves and then pour in hot vinegar.

This mixture must be left for three days before it is ready for use, and although the colour will be purple, this will gradually fade and certainly leave no traces on any surface.

**How long does a lavender plant last?**

Lavender usually lasts around 15 years but they can be replaced more frequently when they have become too woody. Plants look better for longer if cut back hard each year.
